It also provides that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles is to prescribe forms(s) necessary to report motor vehicle accidents to the Bureau of Motor Vehicles for financial responsibility purposes pursuant to R.C. Chapter 4509. and that these forms may include use of a copy of the "Ohio traffic crash report" as part of the reporting requirements. A rule change is proposed to correct the spelling of "procure" to "procedure"
