4501-54-02 **Definitions.**

As used in Chapter 4501-54 of the Administrative Code:

- (A) "Authorizing official" means any person who owns or who maintains responsibility on behalf of an individual, corporation, business trust, estate, trust, partnership, or an association for the facilities, equipment, instructors, managers and other employees of a mature driver enterprise.
- (B) "Certificate of Operation" means the approval of an enterprise to operate a mature operator program as provided by the director of the department of public safety.
- (C) "Course, mature operator course, or mature driver course" means the motor vehicle accident collision prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (D) "Course instructor" means the individual designated by the course operatorapproved by the director of the department of public safety to operate and conduct the motor vehicle accident collision prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (E) "Course operator" means the person approved by the director of the department of public safety to operate a motor vehicle accident prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (F)(E) "Course records" mean the course curriculum, all course materials, instructor's guides, copies of written examinations exercise, and examination exercise scores.
- (G)(F) "Director" means the director of the department of public safety.
- (H)(G) "Drug use" means the use of prescription, over-the-counter, herbal, or nonprescription drugs.
- (H) "Enterprise" means the business approved by the director of the department of public safety to operate a motor vehicle accident collision prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (J)(I) "Participant or student" means a person age sixty or older taking the motor vehicle accident collision prevention course.
- (K)(J) "Skills demonstration" means the portion of the mature operator course that requires the participant to demonstrate the ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a motor vehicle.

(L)(K) "Written exercise" means a written quiz that tests the participant's knowledge based on the classroom instruction of the course.
