4501-54-02 **Definitions.**

As used in Chapter 4501-54 of the Administrative Code:

- (A) "Course" means the motor vehicle accident prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (B) "Course director" means the individual designated by the course operator to conduct the motor vehicle accident prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (C) "Course operator" means the person approved by the director of the department of public safety to operate a motor vehicle accident prevention course for drivers age sixty or older.
- (D) "Course records" mean the course curriculum, all course materials, instructors guides, copies of written examinations, and examination scores.
- (E) "Drug use" means the use of prescription or nonprescription drugs.
- (F) "Participant or student" means a person age sixty or older taking the motor vehicle accident prevention course.
- (G) "Director" means the director of the department of public safety.
