Course written examination and practical examination.

- (A) All course participants are required to pass a written examination administered by the course director. The examination shall consist of not less than twenty-five questions and shall have a mixture of true/false and multiple choice questions. A score of not less than seventy-five per cent is required for satisfactory completion of the written examination
- (B) All course participants are required to pass a practical examination administered by the course director.
- (C) The course director may offer one of the following options for completion of the practical examination:
- (1) On road practical examination - The course instructor shall ride with the student in a motor vehicle on the public roadways through a course that meets the requirements established in rule 4501-54-05 of the Administrative Code and this rule for the practical course.
 - (2) Off road practical examination - The course instructor shall take a position on the off-road practical course that allows him to observe the student's actual operation of a motor vehicle through the course. The off road practical examination shall meet the requirements established in rule 4501-54-05 of the Administrative Code and this rule.
- (D) Evaluation of the practical examination shall be based on the following criteria:
- (1) Did the student drive within marked lanes?
 - (2) Did the student stay in the appropriate lanes when turning?
 - (3) Did the student exercise the proper use of turn signals?
 - (4) Did the student maintain the proper stopping distances at intersections?
 - (5) Did the student exercise vigilance for other traffic?
 - (6) Did the student wear a seat belt?
- (E) The student shall meet all the criteria established in rule 4501-54-05 of the Administrative Code and this rule in demonstrating the ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a motor vehicle for purposes of the practical examination.
