Per Ohio Revised Code section 4511.69, the display of a placard or disability license plate is required in order to park in any space designated for such a purpose within this state. Per Ohio Revised Code section 4503.44 (D) (1) (a), Ohio charges only the service fee of \$3.50 for the issuance of a placard. There is no additional fee. Per section 4503.44 (D) (1) (b), active duty members of the United States armed forced with a service connected disability are issued placards at no cost. Per section 4503.44 (E), veterans with a service-connected disability are issued placards at no cost.
