The BMV receives 50 cents from each vehicle registration renewed using a Self-Service Terminal. The BMV receives the entire Deputy Fee (\$5.00 to \$15.00 depending on the number of years for which the registration is issued) for a registration/renewal completed using our toll-free number or our website. This fee is retained by the Deputy Registrar License Agency if a customer chooses to renew in person. This brings in approximately \$4,478,249 annually.

The cost of vehicle registration varies by vehicle type and number of years. There is a surcharge associated with purchasing a registration renewal using a credit/debit card, but other payment options (i.e. electronic check) are available with no additional fee.
