4715-12-01 **Permissible practices of a dental assistant radiographer;** supervision required; certificate to be displayed.

- (A) A dental assistant radiographer may perform standard, diagnostic, radiologic procedures for the purpose of contributing to the provision of dental care to a dental patient.
- (B) A dental assistant radiographer may perform radiologic procedures only under the direct supervision of the supervising dentist.
- (C) The certificate must be displayed in a conspicuous location in the office in which the dental assistant radiographer is employed, or shall be kept on file at the teaching institutionThe original or copy of the certificate and/or renewal receipt card shall be displayed in a conspicuous place in the office wherein the dental assistant radiographer is employed and be made immediately available upon the request of an agent of the board.
