Pre license nursing education programs must be approved by the Board of Nursing. The rule states that information regarding the availability and effective date of the materials incorporated by reference in the rule can be found in paragraph (G) of Rule 4723-1-03. Rule 4723-1-03 states that the materials are available to the public at <http://www.nursing.ohio.gov/forms.htm>. The material is a digital application into which data is entered to fill out a form or its equivalent, and the form or application merely collects information and does not establish principles of law or policy. Additionally, forms contain data (e.g., calendar dates, references to statutes) that are updated from time to time, and it is infeasible, and not a good use of state resources, to file new rules and hold public rule hearings, each time changes are made to forms.
