Licensure examination.

- (A) Only an individual who successfully completes a program with full, conditional, or provisional approval at the time the individual completes the program, who meets all requirements of the controlling agency, and who meets all requirements set forth in the rules of the board may be eligible to take the licensure examination.
- (B) A program having a pass rate on the licensure examination that falls below eighty-five per cent for first-time candidates in any one calendar year shall:
- (1) Present to the board a plan for identifying possible contributing factors and for correcting any identified deficiencies; and
 - (2) Submit periodic progress reports on a schedule determined by the board.
- (C) The board shall conduct a survey visit in accordance with rule 4723-5-06 of the Administrative Code when a program has a pass rate on the licensure examination that falls below eighty-five percent for first-time candidates in a calendar year for three consecutive calendar years.
