4723-7-05 **Action upon examination results.**

- (A) The results of the examination shall be recorded as reported by the testing service.
- (B) A license shall be issued by the board to the applicant:
 - (1) Who has passed the examination;
 - (2) Who has completed all requirements for licensure in accordance with rule 4723-7-02 of the Administrative Code for graduates of nursing education programs approved by a jurisdiction or in accordance with rule 4723-7-03 of the Administrative Code for foreign educated nurse graduates; and
 - (3) Who has not committed any act which may be grounds for disciplinary action under section 4723.28 of the Revised Code.
- (C) The applicant who has failed the examination shall be informed of the right to repeat the examination in accordance with paragraph (D) of this rule.
- (D) The applicant who fails the examination and applies to repeat the examination shall meet all requirements for admission to the examination as set forth in rule 4723-7-02 or 4723-7-03 of the Administrative Code. The licensure examination may be taken once every three months, or in accordance with the policy determined by the national council of state boards of nursing.
- (E) Programs shall be sent reports of the results attained by their graduates on a schedule established by the board.
