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The addition of clarifying language for the documentation of the required annual review of a standard care arrangement; clarification of the fact that a clinical nurse specialist who does not hold a certificate to prescribe and whose nursing specialty is mental health or psychiatric mental health does not need to enter into a standard care arrangement [RC 4723.431(D)]; provides that a regular review of referrals made to other health care professionals by a certified nurse midwife, certified nurse practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist be based upon a "representative" sample of the clients seen by that nurse; provides that a timely direct, personal evaluation of a client by a collaborating physician be undertaken when indicated; clarifies the use of drugs approved by the Food and Drug Administration and reviewed by the Committee on Prescriptive Governance (CPG) for new indications and when the review by the CPG occurs after the date of the standard care arrangement; clarifies the review by the nurse and the collaborating physician of a representative sample of the prescriptions written by the nurse; and provides that a clinicial nurse specialist whose nursing speciality is mental health or psychiatric mental health must enter into a standard care arrangement if that nurse holds a certificate to prescribe.
