4723-9-03 Completing a course of study in advanced pharmacology.

- (A) To be eligible for a certificate to prescribe, an applicant shall complete, within the three years immediately preceding the application, a course of study, as defined in rule 4723-9-01 of the Administrative Code, that meets the requirements of rule 4723-9-02 of the Administrative Code.
- (B) Notwithstanding paragraph (A) of this rule, on or before October 1, 2004, to be eligible for a certificate to prescribe:
  - (1) An applicant who has successfully completed at least thirty hours of advanced level training in pharmacology within the three years immediately preceding the application shall successfully complete a course of study which consists of a minimum of six contact hours of training that includes information on state and federal drug laws and information on fiscal and ethical implications of prescribing drugs and therapeutic devices; or
  - (2) An applicant who has not completed a minimum of thirty contact hours of advanced level training in pharmacology within the three years immediately preceding the application shall successfully complete a thirty-six hour course of study in advanced pharmacology that meets the requirements of rule 4723-9-02 of the Administrative Code.
