A registered veterinary technician must obtain a license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Ohio.

There is a law (ORC 4741.99) which prescribes the type of cause of action for practicing veterinary medicine without a license.

The law requires the registered veterinary technician to obtain 10 hours of continuing education in order to renew. The rule merely repeats the requirement as stated in ORC 4741.19(C)
