## 4741-1-07 Approved veterinary and animal technology colleges.

A license to practice, or application for examination for licensure may not be granted until satisfactory proof has been furnished to the board that the applicant has graduated from an accredited college of veterinary medicine or a college approved by the licensing board. Such accreditation must be provided by the accreditation committee of the "American Veterinary Medical Association," or the institution must certify to the satisfaction of the board that all the requirements for accreditation are equal to the "American Veterinary Medical Association" accreditation In addition to American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) accredited veterinary programs, the board may approve a veterinary program which certifies to the satisfaction of the board that its veterinary medical degree program is comparable to those accredited by the AVMA.

The register of all colleges and universities that teach veterinary medicine or animal technology and are approved by the board shall be maintained in a form compatible with approved office procedures and in a manner readily available to the board and the public upon request.
