The Board proposes to amend this rule as part of a review which R.C. §106.03 requires the Board to conduct before this rule's five-year deadline.

This rule regulates the approval of training agencies for continuing education.

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The Board proposes to amend this rule in the following ways:

(1) Language added to reflect that Board approval only applies to continuing education programs conducted/sponsored solely by the organization named in the application.

- (2) Language added to reflect that providers shall not submit courses for other organizations or persons that are not providers of BELTSS, and that organizations or persons wanting to put on continuing education programs for nursing home administrators must seek provider status from the Board. Preferred providers shall not submit courses for certified providers to gain preferred status for the provider/course.
