This rule is being amended to correct an error in the minimum passing scores for two sections of the TOEFL iBT. The acceptable passing scores for the two sections in question were transposed when the Physical Therapy Section initially adopted the changes last year. The rule is also being amended to clarify the additional requirements that may be required of endorsement applicants who have been out of the practice of physical therapy for three or more years.

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then summarize the content of the rule:

The first change will correct the passing scores required for the Reading Comprehension section and the Listening Comprehension section of the TOEFL iBT. The correct passing scores are 21 for the Reading Comprehension section and 18 for the Listening Comprehension section.

The second change clarifies the additional activities that may be required of endorsement applicants who have been out of practice for at least three years. These activities, which include remedial education, supervised clinical practice, and retaking the national exam, among others, will help the Physical Therapy Section ensure that applicants possess minimal competence to safely practice physical therapy in the State of Ohio.
