**Application for limited permit.**

- (A) All applications for limited permit shall be submitted to the occupational therapy section on the forms specified by the section.
- (B) A limited permit issued by the occupational therapy section shall expire on the date the certification examination results are received from the national board for certification in occupational therapy, inc. (NBCOT), or four months from the date of issue, whichever comes first.
- (C) Applications shall be:
- (1) Typewritten or printed in ink or submitted electronically via the Ohio e-License system;
  - (2) Signed by the applicant or electronically signed if applying electronically via the Ohio e-License system;
  - (3) Accompanied by the fee prescribed by rule 4755-5-02 of the Administrative Code; and
  - (4) Accompanied by such evidence, statement, or documents as specified on the form.
- (D) An applicant for a limited permit shall:
- (1) Have met the requirements specified in divisions (A) to (C) of section ~~4755.06~~4755.07 of the Revised Code by successfully completing the academic requirement of an occupational therapy program accredited by the accreditation council on occupational therapy education (ACOTE) of the American occupational therapy association (AOTA).
  - (2) Have never previously taken the NBCOT certification examination.
- (E) Extension of the limited permit may be granted at the discretion of the section only for extenuating circumstances.
- (F) For the purposes of filing an electronic application via the Ohio e-License system, the board shall supply the applicant with a "UserID" and password. The use of the "UserID" and password provided by the board is solely the responsibility of the individual to whom it is issued and shall be limited to filing an electronic application for a limited permit. The "UserID" and password shall constitute the legally recognized signature for the purposes of this rule and may not be

transferred, distributed, or shared with any other person.
