4765-10-05 **Report of administrative actions.**

- (A) When the board takes <u>disciplinary</u> action to <u>discipline</u>, <u>suspend</u>, <u>revoke</u>, <u>limit</u>, <u>fail to renew</u>, <u>or fail to issue a certificate against a holder of a certificate to pratice</u>, a <u>certificate of accreditation</u>, a <u>certificate of approval</u>, <u>or a certificate to teach</u>, in accordance with this chapter, <u>it the board</u> shall <u>so</u> advise:
 - (1) The person against whom such action is taken;
 - (2) Any other state or public agencies for whom which such notice is appropriate;
 - (3) The appropriate regional medical director or regional physician advisory board;
 - (4) The medical director of any EMS organizations by whom the person is employed, or with which he is affiliated;
 - (5)(3) Any EMS organizations by whom the person the certificate holder is employed by or with whom he the certificate holder is affiliated.
- (B) All administrative actions that result in discipline, suspension, revocation, or limitation of certification shall be published in the division of EMS newsletter or on the division's website.
- (C) The division shall compile on an annual basis a report on complaints received, investigations conducted, and administrative actions taken.
