## 4765-11-04 **Application for charter.**

- (A) An applicant for a charter for fire service training, issued pursuant to section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter, shall submit the following information on a form prescribed by the executive director:
  - (1) Documentation of compliance with the standards set forth in section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter;
  - (2) The site from which the training program is administered and the classroom and laboratory components of the program are conducted;
  - (3) The name of the program director;
  - (4) A financial statement certifying that the applicant or the training program possess sufficient financial resources to ensure the continued operation of the program for the term the charter will remain valid;
  - (5) Copies of all written agreements between the program and other persons allowing for the use of equipment and apparatus that are necessary for levels one and two of the current NFPA standard 1001;
  - (6) The names of all instructors certified under section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter who provide instruction in the program;
  - (7) Demonstration of compliance with the applicable program curriculum as set forth in this chapter.
- (B) An applicant for a charter issued pursuant to section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter shall allow site inspection by the division of emergency medical services.
- (C) There shall be no application fee.
- (D) Notice shall be provided when an application for a charter issued pursuant to section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter is denied by the executive director.
  - (1) The notice shall state that the applicant for a charter may request a hearing in accordance with Chapter 119. of the Revised Code and that such hearing must be requested within thirty days of the mailing date of the notice of

proposed action.
