TO BE RESCINDED

4765-11-07 Reinstatement of an expired fire charter or classification.

[Comment: For dates and availability of material incorporated by reference in this rule, see paragraph (CC) in rule 4765-11-01 of the Administrative Code.]

- (A) A fire charter or classification that has expired shall be reinstated by the executive director, if all of the following apply:
 - (1) A completed "Fire Charter Application" is submitted to the division.
 - (2) This application is submitted no later than three years after the charter expired;
 - (3) The applicant is in compliance with the requirements of section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and rules 4765-11-02 to 4765-11-03 of the Administrative Code;
 - (4) At the time the charter expired, the charter was not under investigation or disciplinary action for any violations of this chapter and was in good standing.
- (B) An applicant whose charter expired within the time period for reinstatement is not eligible for a new certificate under rule 4765-11-02 of the Administrative Code.
