Revocation of a charter.

(A) The executive director, with the advice and counsel of the committee, may suspend or revoke a charter issued under section 4765.55 of the Revised Code and this chapter for any of the following:

- (1) Failure to meet the minimum standards for chartering set forth in this chapter;
- (2) Violation of any provision of Chapter 4765. of the Revised Code or this chapter;
- (3) Furnishing false, misleading, or incomplete information to the executive director;
- (4) Presentation to prospective students of misleading, false, or fraudulent information relating to any programs, employment opportunities, or opportunities for enrollment in accredited institutions of higher education after entering or completing courses offered by the program;
- (5) Failure to maintain premises and equipment in a safe condition;
- (6) Failure to maintain financial resources sufficient for the continued operation of the program in the manner set forth in the application for charter;
- (7) Discrimination in the acceptance of students on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin .

(B) A program whose charter has been suspended may not conduct, offer, or promote its program during the period for which the charter is suspended.

(C) A program whose charter has been revoked may not apply for reinstatement prior to the date upon which the charter would otherwise have expired.
