Volunteer firefighters.

- (A) A program to train volunteer firefighters shall require that participants successfully complete a fire training program of not more than thirty-six hours that meets the ~~current NFPA standard for~~ prerequisites to participate in live burn evolutions as listed in the NFPA 1403 Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions (2002 edition), which is available at www.nfpa.org, and fire department orientation as listed in NFPA 1001 Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications (2002 edition), which is available at www.nfpa.org. The training shall commence and end within a consecutive twelve-month period.
- (B) A program to train volunteer firefighters shall not include live burn evolutions. Participants in a program to train volunteer firefighters shall be instructed that they cannot perform the duties of a firefighter or participate in live burn evolutions prior to obtaining their state certification.
