## 4765-11-10 Volunteer firefighters.

- (A) A program to train volunteer firefighters shall require that participants successfully complete a fire training program of not more than thirty-six hours that meets the eurrent NFPA standard for prerequisites to participate in live burn evolutions <u>as</u> <u>listed in the NFPA 1403 Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions (2002 edition).</u> <u>which is available at www.nfpa.org.</u> and fire department orientation <u>as listed in NFPA 1001 Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications (2002 edition).</u> <u>which is available at www.nfpa.org</u>. The training shall commence and end within a consecutive twelve-month period.
- (B) A program to train volunteer firefighters shall not include live burn evolutions. Participants in a program to train volunteer firefighters shall be instructed that they cannot perform the duties of a firefighter or participate in live burn evolutions prior to obtaining their state certification.
