

## TO BE RESCINDED

4765-11-10            **Volunteer firefighters.**

- (A) A program to train volunteer firefighters shall require that participants successfully complete a fire training program of not more than thirty-six hours that meets the prerequisites to participate in live burn evolutions as listed in the "NFPA 1403 Standard on Live Fire Training Evolutions (2002 edition)," which is available at [www.nfpa.org](http://www.nfpa.org), and fire department orientation as listed in "NFPA 1001 Standard for Fire Fighter Professional Qualifications (2002 edition)," which is available at [www.nfpa.org](http://www.nfpa.org). The training shall commence and end within a consecutive twelve-month period.
- (B) A program to train volunteer firefighters shall not include live burn evolutions. Participants in a program to train volunteer firefighters shall be instructed that they cannot perform the duties of a firefighter or participate in live burn evolutions prior to obtaining their state certification.
