

## TO BE RESCINDED

4765-11-10                    **Firefighter I transition course.**

[Comment: For dates and availability of material incorporated by reference in this rule, see paragraph (CC) in rule 4765-11-01 of the Administrative Code.]

- (A) A training course to transition a certified volunteer firefighter to the firefighter I certification level shall meet the "Firefighter I Course Objectives," to include the following training requirements:
- (1) A minimum of one hundred hours that meets all objectives in the "NFPA 1001," for firefighter I;
  - (2) An emergency vehicle operator course consisting of a minimum of sixteen hours that is approved by the chartered program and is consistent with the requirements of "NFPA 1451" and "NFPA 1002;"
  - (3) A minimum of four hours on the "Courage to be Safe, Sixteen Life Safety Initiatives Course."
- (B) The chartered program shall require a current and valid volunteer firefighter certificate for admission to a firefighter I transition course.
- (C) The training requirements listed in paragraph (A) of this rule shall commence and end within a consecutive twelve-month period.
