4765-11-11 **Firefighter I curriculum.**

- (A) A training program for firefighter I certification shall consist of not less than one hundred twenty hours and meet all objectives in the NFPA standard 1001, firefighter I. In addition, students must also successfully complete a sixteen-hour emergency vehicle operation course approved by the chartered program that meets the requirements of NFPA standards 1451 and 1002.
- (B) The training listed in paragraph (A) of this rule shall commence and end within a consecutive twelve-month period.
- (C) A chartered program shall issue a document of course completion to each student who successfully completes the firefighter I course and provides written documentation of successful completion of the following training courses:

National incident management system course IS-700 and incident command system course IS-100, both of which can be accessed at the federal emergency management agency web site (<http://training.fema.gov/emiweb/IS/crslist.asp> for online courses or http://www.fema.gov/emergency/nims/nims_compliance.shtm (March 1, 2004) for materials and information on instructor lead classroom-based courses). These courses are also listed on the division of place EMS web site (<http://www.ems.ohio.gov>). Completion of the above topics is mandated by the department of homeland security pursuant to homeland security presidential directives five (HSPD-5, February 28, 2003) and eight (HSPD-8, December 17, 2003) and approved by the executive director as being necessary for initial training.
