4765-11-12 Firefighter II transition course.

[Comment: For dates and availability of material incorporated by reference in this rule, see paragraph (CC) in rule 4765-11-01 of the Administrative Code.]

- (A) A training course to transition a certified firefighter I to the firefighter II certification level shall meet the "Firefighter II Course Objectives," to include the following training requirements:
 - (1) A minimum of one hundred four hours that meets all objectives in the NFPA 1001, for firefighter II;
 - (2) An emergency vehicle operator course consisting of a minimum of sixteen hours that is approved by the chartered program and is consistent with the requirements of "NFPA 1002" and "NFPA 1451;
 - (3) A minimum of four hours on the "Courage to be Safe, Sixteen Life Safety Initiatives Course."
- (B) Previous training credit may be given for paragraphs (A)(2) to (A)(3) of this rule, if the training is recognized by the program director of a chartered program and has been completed within twenty-four months of the course start date.
- (C) The chartered program shall require certification as a firefighter I for admission to a firefighter II transition course.
- (D) The training requirements listed in paragraph (A) of this rule shall commence and end within a consecutive twelve-month period.
