4765-12-04 **First responder instructor curriculum.**

- (A) A first responder instructor training program shall consist of a minimum of forty-six hours allocated among the following areas:
 - (1) Six hours in the review and update of the first responder curriculum knowledge and skill objectives;
 - (2) Except as provided in paragraph (B) of this rule, thirty-six hours in instruction of adult students and basic teaching techniques; and
 - (3) Except as provided in paragraph (E) of this rule, four hours of supervised teaching in the presence of a person who holds a current certificate to teach at the first responder level.
- (B) A person seeking certification under section 4765.23 of the Revised Code as a first responder instructor who holds at least a baccalaureate degree in adult education from an accredited institution deemed acceptable by the board, need only complete that portion of an first responder instructor program set forth in paragraph (A)(1) of this rule.
- (C) A first responder instructor training program for current EMT instructors and current fire service instructors who hold a EMS certificate to practice shall consist of six hours in the review and update of the first responder curriculum knowledge and skill objectives.
