This rule is being amended in part, to implement changes to the emergency medical responder or first responder scope of practice. Additionally, the rule is being amended to implement statutory changes set forth by Sub. H.B. 128, 129th General Assembly which deems a reference to a first responder as a reference to an emergency medical responder or EMR.

The rule sets forth the emergency medical services that may be performed by an emergency medical responder and the conditions under which they may be performed. The EMS board, in accordance with section 4765.35 of the Revised Code, approved the addition of controlling of hemorrhaging to the emergency medical responder scope of practice, approved the addition of eye irrigation, pulse oximeter and capnography equipment application and reading only pursuant to written or verbal authorization of a physician and clarified that a emergency medical responder may assist in emergency childbirth management. Also, references to "first responder" were changed to "emergency medical responder."
