This rule is being filed according to a R.C. 119.032 review. This rule is also proposed to replace existing rule 4765-20-07 due to LSC's fifty percent guideline. It is estimated that changes to the new rule strike approximately fifty percent of the text in the existing rule while adding a comparable amount of new text.

This rule sets forth the requirements for renewal of a fire fighter and fire safety inspector certificate. Changes to this new rule separate firefighter and fire safety inspector requirements into separate paragraphs for clarity sake. The rule now requires the Division to notify each person of the expiration date of the individual's firefighter or fire safety inspector certificate no later than sixty days prior to the expiration date. Additionally, language was added to this rule to identify that the dates and availability of materials incorporated by reference are located in rule 4765-11-01(N) (See filing package 114977).
