Provisional accreditation of training programs.

- (A) The division, as directed by the board shall issue a certificate of accreditation on a provisional basis pursuant to section 4765.17 of the Revised Code, to any applicant who is of good reputation and who demonstrates substantial compliance with the requirements for accreditation as defined in this chapter.
- (B) In issuing a certificate of provisional accreditation the division shall indicate to an applicant those requirements set forth in paragraphs (A)(11) and (A)(12), of rule 4765-7-02 of the Administrative Code, with which he has failed to demonstrate compliance.
- (C) A certificate of accreditation issued on a provisional basis is valid for a period of one year and shall not be renewed.
- (D) When an applicant demonstrates compliance with all requirements identified by the board pursuant to paragraph (B) of this rule, the division, as directed by the board shall issue a certificate of accreditation which shall be valid for three years from the date of issue.
- (E) If an applicant is unable to demonstrate compliance with those requirements identified by the board pursuant to paragraph (B) of this rule within one year after being issued a certificate of accreditation on a provisional basis, he may not submit an application for the training program that was the subject of the provisional accreditation for a period of at least one year. No applicant shall be issued a second provisional accreditation.
