This rule is being filed in order to amend the passing percentage that accredited schools must meet in order to become renewed. Additionally, language is being added to the rule that will allow the Division of EMS to send renewal applications electronically.

Current language requires accredited schools to show a 65% passage rate among students taking the initial certification examination in their first attempt. Amended language considers more than just the first-time passage rate. In order to be eligible for renewal under the amended rule, schools must show that during their accreditation cycle at least 80% of their students who took the certification examination passed, regardless of the number of attempts. Other amended language entails adding the word "distribute" rather than "mail" in regards to sending out a renewal application. This language change will allow the Division of EMS to send renewal applications electronically.
