Reinstatement of certificate of accreditation.

- (A) A certificate of accreditation that has expired may be reinstated by the division, as directed by the board if both of the following apply:
- (1) Application for reinstatement is made no later than ninety days after the certificate of accreditation expired;
 - (2) The division determines that the applicant for reinstatement is in compliance with the requirements of section 4765.16 of the Revised Code and this chapter.
- (B) The holder of a certificate of accreditation that has been suspended by the board pursuant to section 4765.33 of the Revised Code and this chapter, may not apply for reinstatement prior to the date at which the certificate of accreditation would otherwise have expired.
- (C) The board may charge any reinstatement fee that it establishes on an annual basis.
