Reinstatement of revoked certificate of accreditation or certificate of approval, or provisional certificate of accreditation or approval.

- (A) The board is not obligated to reinstate a any certificate of accreditation or a certificate of approval issued under this chapter that has been previously revoked by the board.
- (B) The board shall not reinstate a any certificate of accreditation or a certificate of approval issued under this chapter that has been permanently revoked.
- (C) The board shall not reinstate a any certificate of accreditation or a certificate of approval certificate issued under this chapter that has been revoked less than one year from the date on which the board order revoking such certificate of ~~accreditation or certificate of approval~~ is journalized with the board.
- (D) ~~A~~ Any certificate of accreditation or certificate of approval issued under this chapter that has been revoked by the board for at least one year from the date the revocation order was journalized with the board but no more than three years is eligible for reinstatement ~~after one year from the date the order revoking the certificate was journalized with the board~~. In order to be reinstated, the institution must meet all requirements for a certificate of accreditation or a certificate of approval as outlined in Chapter 4765-7 of the Administrative Code this chapter.
- (E) In addition to having the applicant meet requirements set forth in this chapter, the board may also take into consideration other relevant factors, including but not limited to he following, when determining whether to grant a request for reinstatement:
- (1) The nature and severity of the acts which resulted in revocation of the certificate ~~of accreditation or certificate of approval~~;
 - (2) The time lapsed since the revocation;
 - (3) Compliance with previous board orders or board approved consent agreements.
