This rule is being filed pursuant to a completed R.C. 119.032 five-year rule review. This rule is being proposed for rescission due to LSC's fifty percent guideline. It is estimated that changes to the rule strike approximately half of the existing text while adding a comparable amount of new text. This rule is simultaneously being

proposed as a new rule under the same rule number.

A.) Does this rule require a license, permit, or any other prior authorization to engage in or operate a line of business? **Yes**

This rule is proposed for rescission and simultaneous adoption under this same rule number. However, this rule and other provisions in Chapter 4765-7 of the Administrative Code (O.A.C.) required institutions to receive approval from the Emergency Medical, Fire, and Transportation Services Board (Board) for a certificate of accreditation prior to offering emergency medical responder (EMR), emergency medical technician (EMT), advanced emergency medical technician (AEMT) or paramedic training programs.

B.) Does this rule impose a criminal penalty, a civil penalty, or another sanction, or create a cause of action, for failure to comply with its terms? **Yes**

This rule is proposed for rescission and simultaneous adoption under this same rule number. However, failure to comply with the terms set forth in this rule may have resulted in an application for a certificate of accreditation to be denied, while other provisions in 4765.18 of the Revised Code (R.C.) establish that the Board may impose an administrative sanction, up to and including revocation of a certificate of accreditation, for any violation of R.C. Chapter 4765 or any rule adopted under it.

C.) Does this rule require specific expenditures or the report of information as a condition of compliance? **Yes**

This rule is proposed for rescission and simultaneous adoption under this same rule number. However, this rule required an accredited institution to submit a written request to the Board prior to offering EMS training programs utilizing formats alternative to the traditional classroom setting.
