Continuing education requirement.

- (A) Unless the holder of a certificate to practice elects to take an examination administered by the board in accordance with section 4765.29 of the Revised Code, or is granted an exemption under section 4765.31 of the Revised Code, he shall complete an emergency medical services continuing education program of such length and in such subject areas as set forth in this chapter.
- (B) Emergency medical services continuing education credit may be offered and earned in the following forms:
- (1) Classroom or seminar;
 - (2) Individual study;
 - (3) Skills practicum;
 - (4) Other formats approved by the board.
- (C) The board shall approve those persons whose educational programs or courses of study satisfy the requirements set forth in section 4765.31 of the Revised Code and this chapter for continuing education programs. Among those who shall be considered to be acceptable sources are:
- (1) EMS training programs accredited by the board under section 4765.17 of the Revised Code;
 - (2) EMS continuing education programs approved by the board under section 4765.17 of the Revised Code;
- (D) A course shall be considered to meet the requirements of section 4765.16 of the Revised Code, when upon successful completion of the course a certificate is issued and the course has been approved for continuing education credit by one of the following:
- (1) An EMS licensing agency in another state;
 - (2) The national registry of emergency medical technicians;
 - (3) The United States military;

- (4) Topics related to ems operation or patient care approved by a medical or nursing licensing board of this state or of another state;
- (5) A course related to EMS operations or patient care offered through a journal or publication of a state or national medical, nursing, or EMS organization, when upon successful completion of an examination, a certificate of completion is issued.
