## 4766-2-04 **Physical facilities.**

[Comment: For dates and availability of material incorporated by reference in this chapter of the Administrative Code, see rule 4766-2-18 of the Administrative Code.]

- (A) The board <u>or its designee</u> shall conduct initial and renewal inspections of all MTOs pursuant to Chapter 4766. of the Revised Code and rules 4766-2-04<del>, 4766-2-05,</del> andto 4766-2-06 of the Administrative Code, to include the following:
  - (1) MTO service headquarters;
  - (2) MTO service satellite base(s).
- (B) A MTO shall not commence operations from its headquarters or satellite <u>base(s)</u> until the location is licensed as <del>required by division (G) of</del> <u>set forth in</u> section 4766.04 of the Revised Code.
- (C) A MTO shall ensure compliance with the inspection requirements for physical facilities. The inspection requirements for physical facilities of a MTO are as follows:
  - (1) <u>Board The board</u> issued license shall be prominently displayed in conspicuous location at every licensed facility (renewal inspection only);
  - (2) <u>State of</u> Ohio state board of pharmacy license(s) shall be displayed <u>at each</u> <u>location;</u>
  - (3) A written sanitation plan <u>as set forth in Chapter 4766-2 of the Administrative</u> <u>Code</u> shall be on site <u>for each location;</u>
  - (4) The physical facilities shall maintain all single use supplies and equipment as set forth in rule 4766-2-10 of the Administrative Codethe "Ambulance Inspection" form.
  - (5) The physical facilities shall be clean and free of debris;
  - (6) Crew quarters shall be clean-:
  - (7) All physical facilities shall be in compliance with state and local building codes;

(8) Each facility shall be in compliance with state and local fire codes.

(D) The board or its designee may conduct routine unannounced inspections at any

location of <u>a</u> licensed MTO at any time, including night or weekend inspections, to determine compliance with Chapter 4766. of the Revised Code and <u>agency</u> <u>agency</u> 4766 of the Administrative Code to include, but not limited to, the following:

- (1) MTO service headquarters;
- (2) MTO service satellite base(s);
- (3) Ambulance(s) and non-transport vehicles(s).
