Change in Status of Service Level.

(A) The application for change in certification level as a basic, intermediate, or advanced licensed MTO shall be made on such forms prescribed by the board and shall include the following:

(1) The name, address and license number of the functioning medical director for the licensed MTO, who shall assure that the MTO conforms with all standards as outlined and defined by law and rule;

(2) Documentation of an appropriate drug license number as prescribed by the state board of pharmacy;

(3) Evidence of functional pre-hospital and inter-hospital protocols in which all basic, intermediate, and advanced personnel are trained and certified or licensed to perform. Protocols must be available at all locations.

(B) A MTO licensed at the basic life support level may apply at any time to be licensed at the intermediate or advanced life support level. The application shall be made on a form prescribed by the board and include the one hundred dollar service fee. A change in level of service does not change the expiration date of the license.

(C) A MTO licensed at the intermediate life support level may apply at any time to be licensed at the advanced life support level. The application shall be made on a form prescribed by the board and include the one hundred dollar service fee. A change in level of service does not change the expiration date of the license.

(D) A MTO licensed at the intermediate or advanced life support level shall notify the board in writing within ten days of any permanent decrease in the level of service to be provided.
