Rule 4766-3-15 requires ambulette services to use the MTLS online system to document additions, deletions, and changes in the organizations' structure and ownership and management personnel; tax identification numbers; and contact information for the organization; some changes require ambulette services to submit a fee. The MTLS online system is expected to reduce the cost and the time required to report required information to the Board.
