Rule 4766-4-13 sets forth the staffing requirements, including the number of staff and the required certification levels, for MTOs licensed to provide MolCU transport services. Paragraph (A) of the rule sets forth the training requirements for personnel who serves as a driver/operator of an MolCU vehicle for a licensed MTO. The training and certification requirements for healthcare personnel serving on an MolCU

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vehicle are set forth in paragraph (B). A new paragraph (C) is added to set forth staffing requirements for a mobile intensive stroke unit. The term "driver/operator" is amended in the first two paragraphs to match the term used throughout the rule.
