Rule 4766-4-15 requires MTOs to use the MTLS online system to document additions, deletions, and changes in the organizations' structure and ownership and management personnel; contact information for the medical director; tax identification numbers; and contact information for the organization; some changes require MTOs to submit a \$100 fee. The MTLS online system is expected to reduce the cost and the time required to report required information to the Board.

Rule 4766-4-15 requires an MTO applying to change its level of service to a higher license level to submit a \$100 license fee. In addition, An MTO is required to use the MTLS on-line system to provide information about its business in order to request a change in its level of service, to delete a vehicle from service, to change its headquarters' address, or to notify the Board of specific changes to the organization.

Rule 4766-4-15 may reduce revenues or increase expenses, depending on the number of times it submits a request to change to a higher level of service.
