Original license certificate and wallet identification card.

- (A) The board shall prepare and provide to each licensee an identification card. Each identification card shall contain the person's name, license or permit number, license type information as to the type of authorization under which they practice, and date of expiration.
- (B) Official license wall certificates shall bear the signatures of the board president and/or the executive director.
- (C) Neither the holder nor anyone else shall make any alterations on a certificate or identification card issued by the board.
- (D) Regardless of the original issue date, all licenses issued pursuant to Revised Code sections 4779.10, 4779.11, 4779.12, 4779.13, 4779.16, and 4779.17 shall expire on the thirty-first day of January following issuance of the license.
- (E) A license issued pursuant to Revised Code section 4779.18 expires one year after issuance, and may only be renewed once.
- ~~(E)~~(F) Original license identification cards are valid proof of current authorization.
