4901:1-15-03 **Definitions.**

As used in this chapter:

- (A) "Company service line" means that portion of the service line between the distribution or collection main and the curb stop, water outlet connection, or sewer inlet connection at or near the property line, right-of-way, or easement line, maintained at the cost of the company.
- (B) "Customer" means any person who enters a contractual agreement with the company to receive waterworks and/or sewage disposal service.
- (C) "Customer service line" means that portion of the service line from the company's service line to the structure or premises which is supplied, installed, and maintained at the cost of the customer.
- (D) "Service connection" means the connection of the company's service line with the customer's service line at or near the property line, which connection enables the customer to receive service.
- (E) "Tap-in" means the connecting of a company service line to the distribution or collection main.
