4901:1-7-02 **Application of rules.**

- (A) The rules contained in Chapter 4901:1-7 of the Administrative Code, apply to any telephone utility under the jurisdiction of the commission, which is now, or may hereafter be, engaged in the business of rendering telephone service to the public.
- (B) These rules shall not preclude the commission from requiring the furnishing of any additional service, equipment, facilities, or standards affecting local exchange service, message toll service, or EAS either upon complaint, the commission's own motion, or upon the application of any telephone utility.
- (C) The commission may relieve any telephone utility from the obligations imposed by these rules, should special circumstances warrant such relief. Any company requiring relief shall file a request with the commission at the earliest known opportunity.
- (D) These rules do not relieve any telephone utility from any of its duties under law.
