4901:1-7-02 General applicability.

- (A) Each citation contained within this chapter that is made to either a section of the United States code or to a regulation in the code of federal regulations is intended, and shall serve, to incorporate by reference the particular version of the eited matter as effective on August 22, 2007.
- (B)(A) The obligations found in rules 4901:1-7-03 to 4901:1-7-29 491:1-7-27 of the Administrative Code, shall apply to all telephone companies pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 251 and 252, as effective in paragraph (A) of this rule.
- (C)(B) The commission may for good cause shown <u>and consistent with state and federal</u> <u>law</u>, waive any requirement, standard, or rule set forth in this chapter, <u>other than a</u> <u>requirement mandated by statute unless such waiver is permitted by the terms of the statute</u>.
- (D)(C) Any telephone company seeking a waiver(s) of rules contained in this chapter shall specify the period of time for which it seeks such a waiver(s), and a detailed justification in the form of a motion filed in accordance with rule 4901-1-12 of the Administrative Code.
- (E)(D) All waiver requests must be approved by the commission and will toll any automatic approval time frames set forth in rule 4901:1-6-08 4901:1-6-05 of the Administrative Code.
