4901:2-7-15 Extensions and relief from default or other order.

- (A) Any time within which a respondent is required to act under this chapter may be extended by the <u>transportation department</u> director in writing, for good cause shown.
- (B) Any time within which the staff is required to act under this chapter may be extended by the written agreement of all parties.
- (C) Extensions of time sought after the commencement of a hearing proceeding shall be governed by Chapter 4901-1 of the Administrative Code.
- (D) A party which is in default or has failed to comply with a settlement agreement, and has been subjected to an ex parte order of the commission may file an application for rehearing in accordance with rule <u>4901:1-354901-1-35</u> of the Administrative Code.
