This rule sets forth the training requirements for public children services child welfare caseworkers. It has been amended to increase training to one hundred and two hours during the first year of continuous employment for public children services agency caseworkers. The rule will also include first year training requirements for students who successfully completed the University Partnership Program and go to work for a public children services agency upon graduation.

The amplification for this rule was also changed from 5153.75 to 5153.125 as a result of S.B. 238.
