

ACTION: ORIGINAL
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Requirements for substitute care placement disruptions.

(A) When there is a disruption of a child's substitute care placement, the PCSA public children services agency (PCSA) or PCPA private child placing agency (PCPA) shall address and document in the case record the following information:

(1) Length of time the child was in the particular substitute care setting.

(2) Circumstances which led to the child's removal.

(3) Any efforts to maintain the placement, including supportive services offered to the child and caregiver.

(B) A disruption of a child's substitute care placement shall require an amendment to the case plan pursuant to rule 5101:2-39-081 for a PCSA or rule 5101:2-39-10 of the Administrative Code for a PCPA.

(C) If a disruption of a child's substitute care placement occurs prior to the child's dispositional hearing, the PCSA or PCPA shall follow procedural requirements pursuant to rule 5101:2-42-93 of the Administrative Code.

(D) The PCSA or PCPA shall maintain a written copy of the information identified in this rule in the case record and the caregiver's record.
