TO BE RESCINDED

5101:2-44-08 Redetermination of a state adoption subsidy.

- (A) The public children services agency (PCSA) shall complete a redetermination of each state adoption subsidy one year from the approval date of the subsidy. An annual redetermination is not required for a subsidy that is suspended pursuant to rule 5101:2-44-10 of the Administrative Code.
- (B) The PCSA shall provide written notice to the adoptive parent at least sixty days prior to the anniversary date of the subsidy approval or most recent redetermination to initiate the annual redetermination process.
- (C) The following procedures constitute a redetermination.
 - (1) The PCSA shall determine, from information submitted by the adoptive parent, whether or not the child and the adoptive parent remain eligible pursuant to rules 5101:2-44-05 and 5101:2-44-06 of the Administrative Code.
 - (2) The PCSA shall complete the redetermination and provide written notification to the adoptive parent of the redetermination outcome at least fifteen days prior to the anniversary date of the subsidy approval or most recent redetermination or within thirty days of a request for modification.
 - (a) If the redetermination results in no change or an increase in the type or amount of subsidy, the notification shall contain such information and the effective date of the redetermined subsidy.
 - (b) If the redetermination results in a decrease, suspension or termination of the subsidy, the notification shall contain the reason for the action, its effective date and a description of the procedures for a review pursuant to rule 5101:2-33-04 of the Administrative Code.
- (D) The PCSA shall redetermine the state adoption subsidy more often than annually if there are substantial changes in the adoptive parent's financial situation or the child's special needs.
- (E) If the adoptive parent fails to comply with the requirements of a redetermination as described in this rule, the PCSA shall suspend the state adoption subsidy pursuant to rule 5101:2-44-10 of the Administrative Code or terminate the state adoption subsidy pursuant to rule 5101:2-44-11 of the Administrative Code.
