This rule is being proposed for filing to add new language requiring specific information to be included in the Child Study Inventory (CSI), to require specific disclosure information based upon SB 27 mandates, to require the completion of the new form, JFS 01667 "Adoption Information Disclosure," and to remove language referencing the AdoptOHIO program.

This rule is proposed because it contains new requirements as a result of SB 27. Paragraph (A) requires earlier initiation of the CSI. Paragraph (A)(1) requires detailed information regarding the child's biological family. Paragraph (A)(3) refers to a new form number for the Social and Medical History form. Paragraphs (A)(5) through (A)(8) include new information disclosure requirements as a result of SB 27. Paragraph (C) requires the agency to provide a copy of the CSI to the following agencies prior to the adoptive placement: public children services agency (PCSA), private child placing agency (PCPA), or private noncustodial agency (PNA. Paragraph (C) also removes the reference to the AdoptOHIO program. Paragraphs (D), (E), and (F) address new program requirements.
